# GRANNY SQUARE JACKET PATTERN

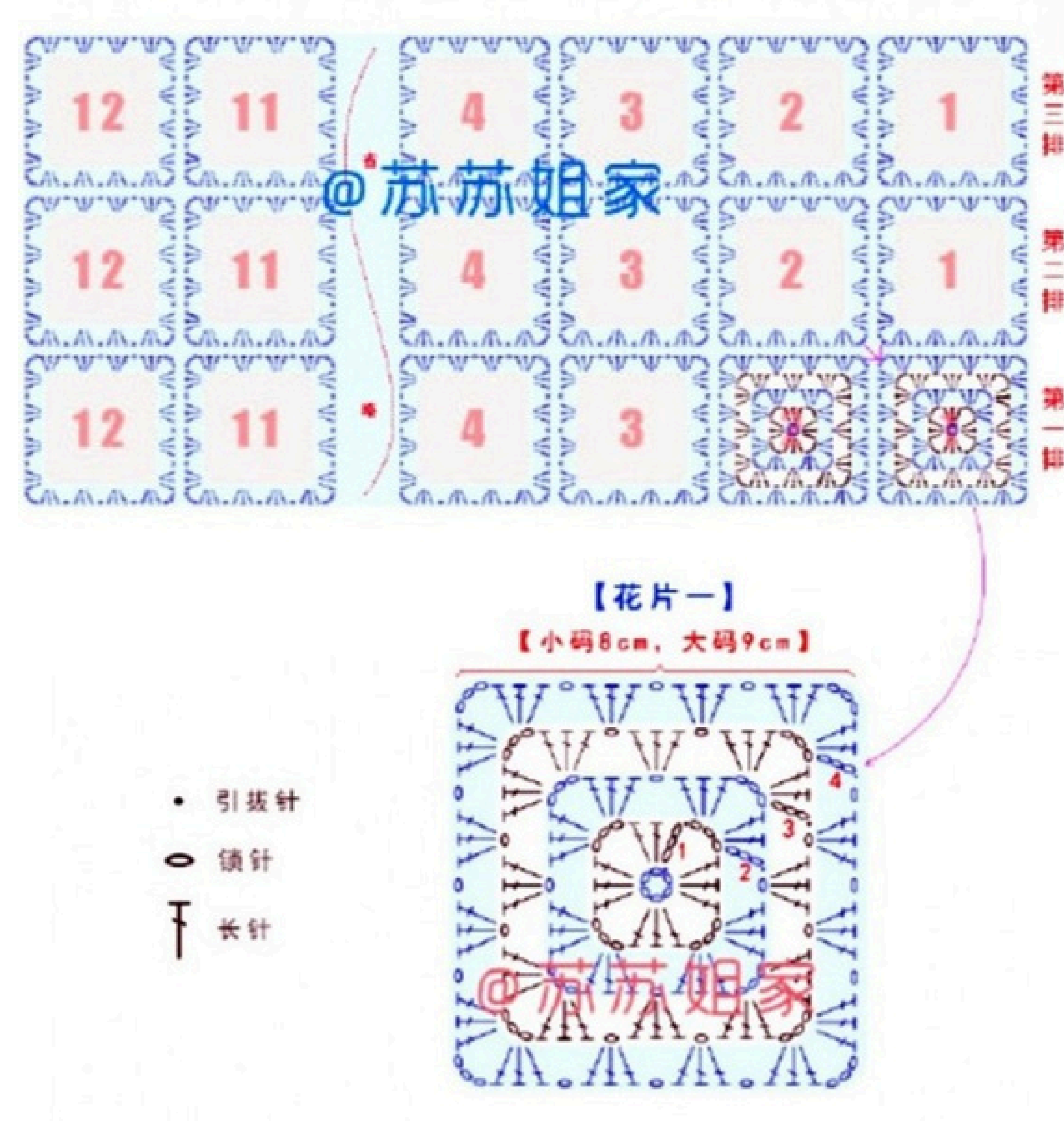


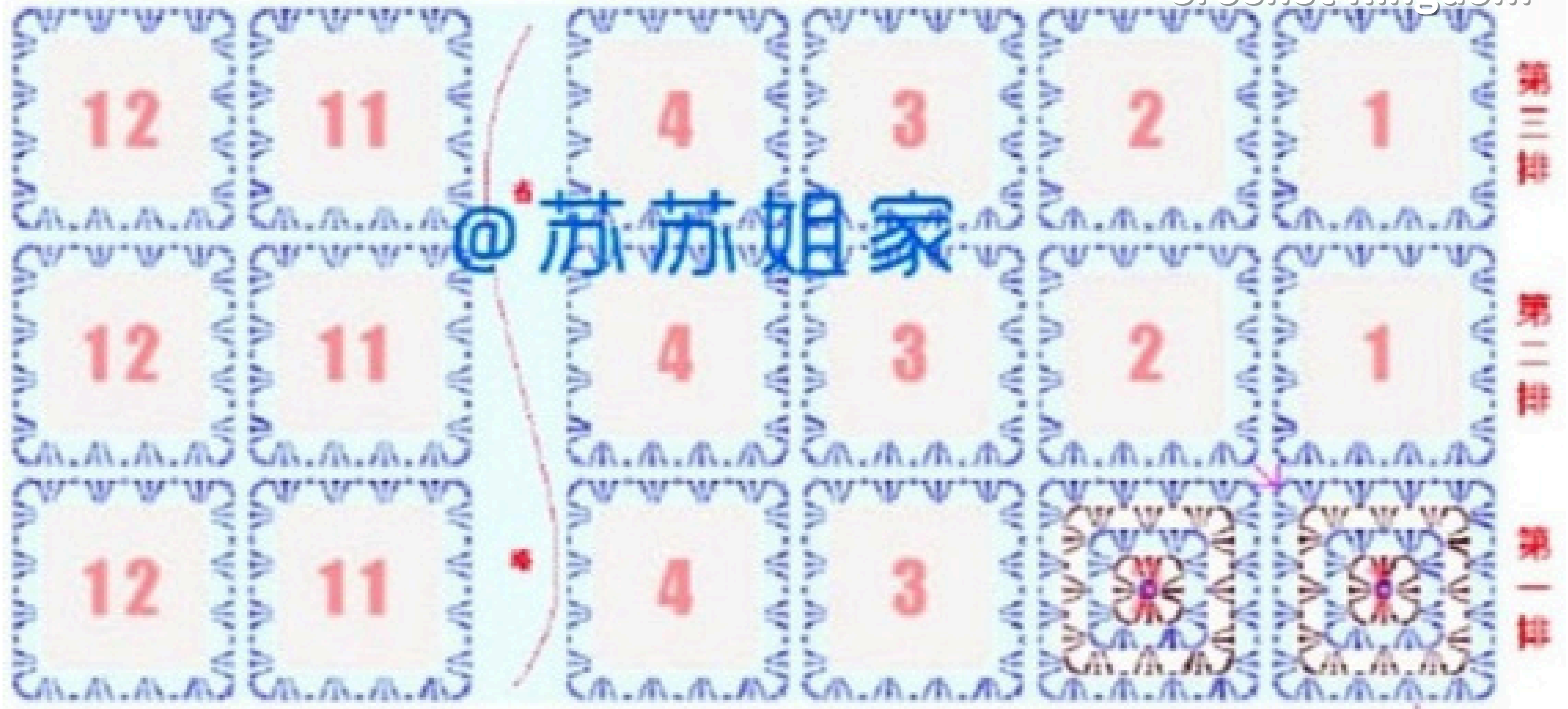

## PART 1: Body

- The body is made by joining a certain number of floral motifs.
- Note that only the first motif is completed separately.
- The remaining motifs are joined as-you-go during the final round.
- Each row of motifs is connected from right to left.

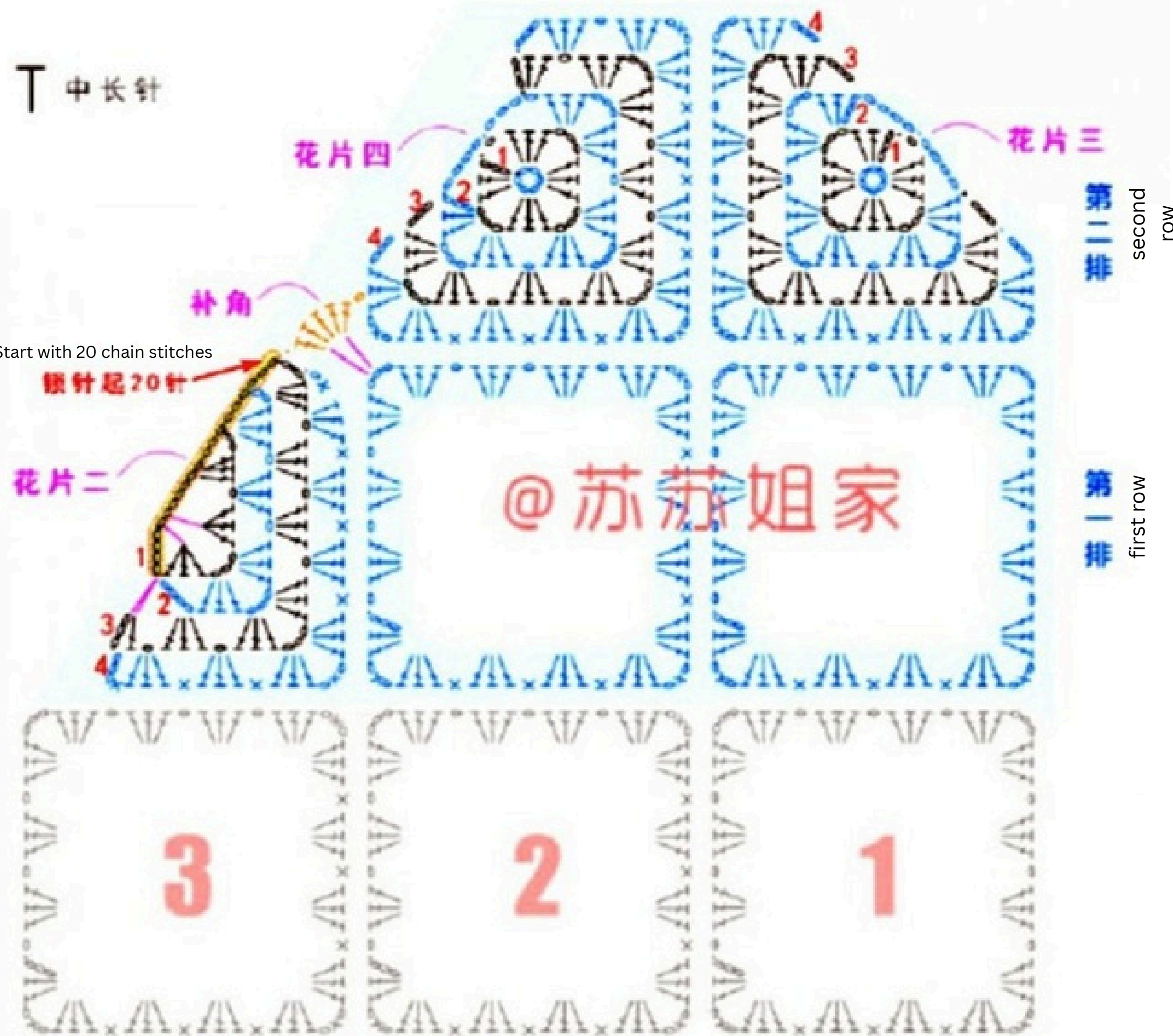
## PART 2: Chest Section

Continue crocheting upward from the body section. This part is divided into three sections: the left front panel, the back panel, and the right front panel.

## STEP 1: Left Front Panel

- The left front panel consists of 2 rows and uses 4 different motifs: Motif 1, Motif 2, Motif 3, and Motif 4.
- After joining the motifs, you will need to crochet corner fillers to complete the shape.

Start with 20 chain stitches



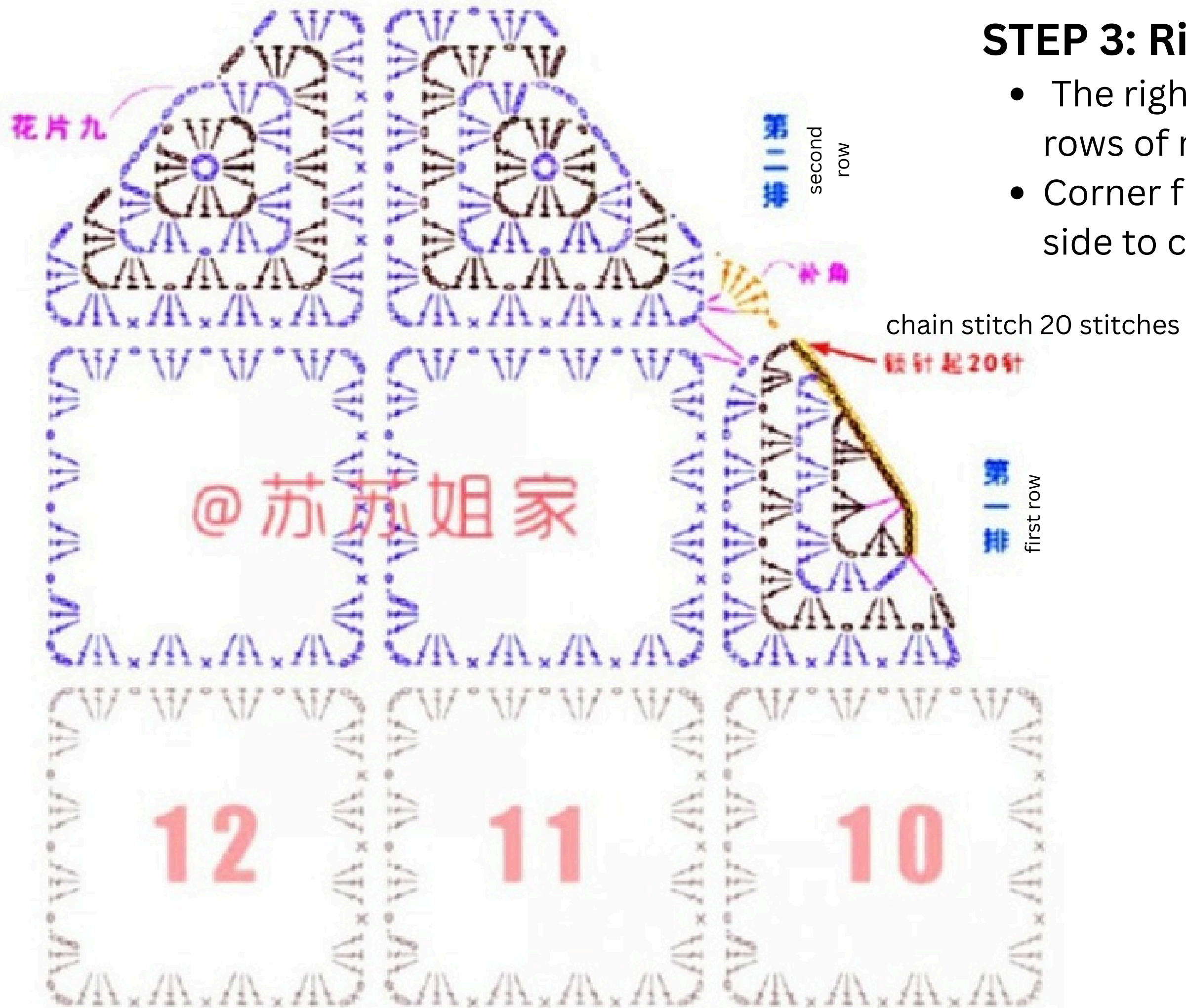
## STEP 2: Back Panel

- The back panel consists of 3 rows and uses 7 different motifs.



### STEP 3: Right Front Panel

- The right front panel is formed by joining 2 rows of motifs.
- Corner fillers are crocheted on the right side to complete the shape.





## PART 3: Sleeves

The sleeve is divided into three sections: the sleeve edge, sleeve body, and sleeve cap. First, crochet the left and right sleeve bodies along with the sleeve caps. Then, work the sleeve edge.

At the cuff, crochet one round of single crochet, then pick up stitches around the edge and work in double rib stitch (k2, p2) in the round.

Once the sleeve is complete, join it to the armhole sections of the front and back panels using slip stitches and chain stitches. Finally, connect the corner filler motifs.

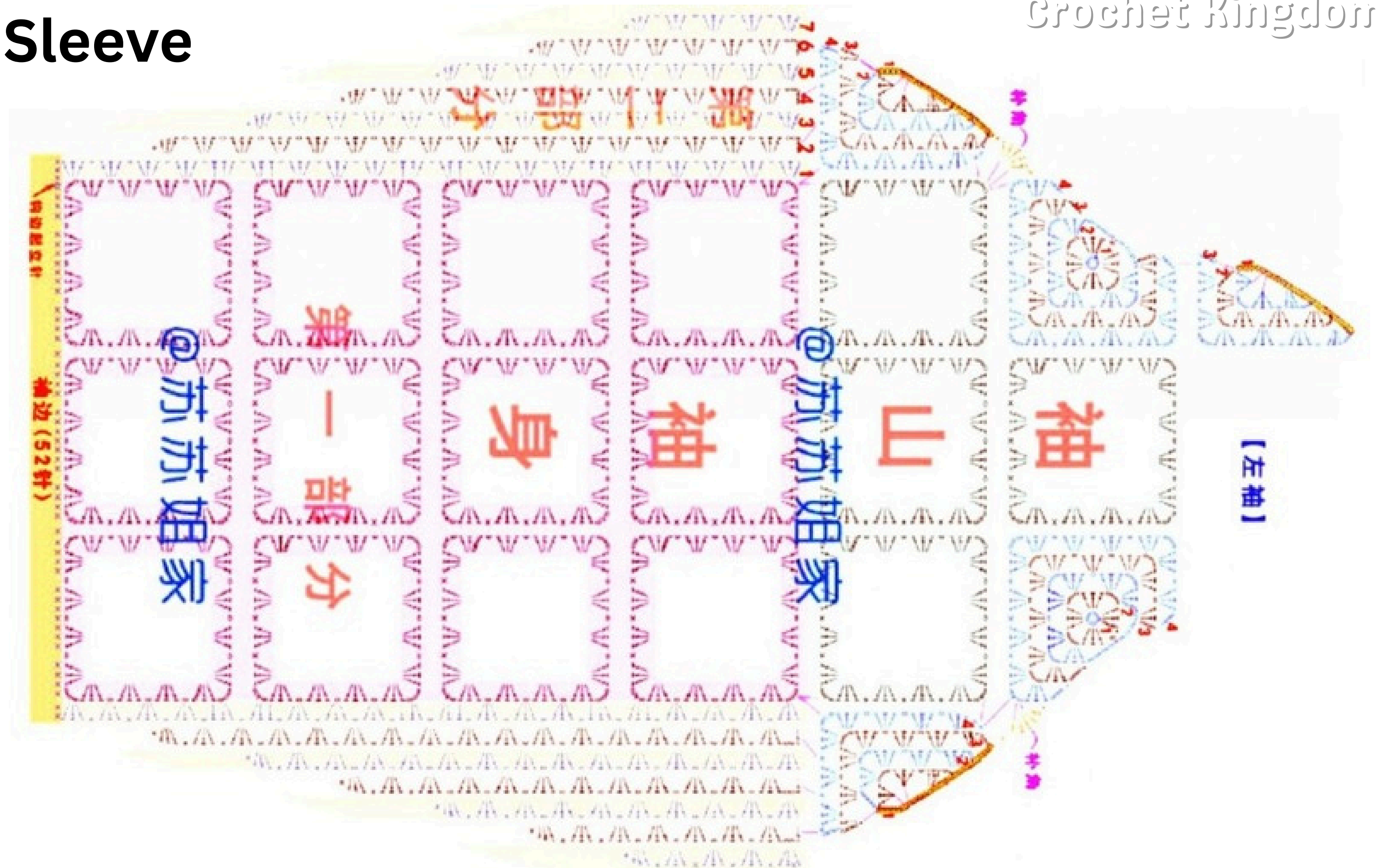
### STEP 1: Sleeve Body and Sleeve Cap

The crochet methods for the left and right sleeves are slightly different.

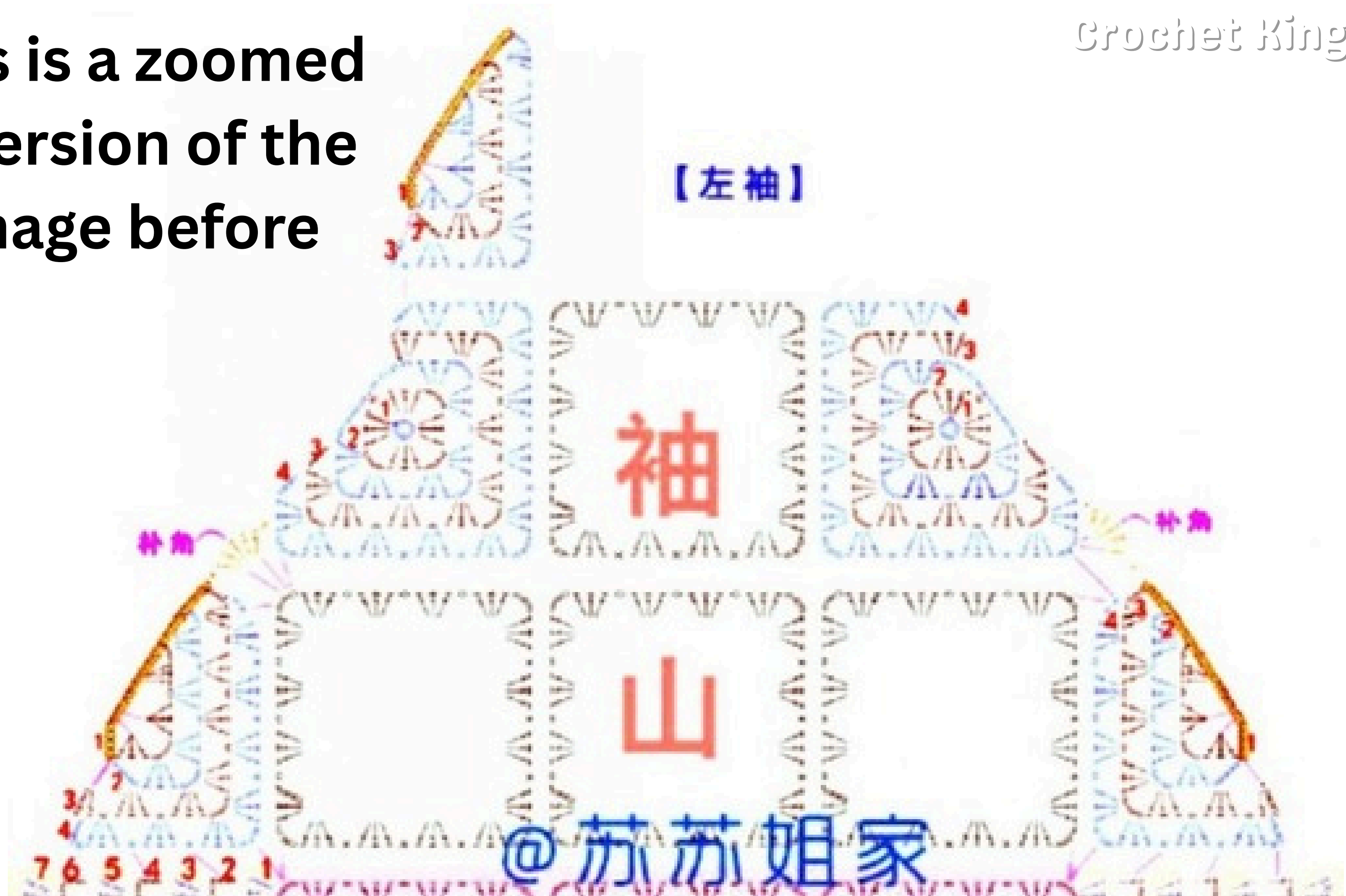
#### Note:

- The edge motifs on the sleeve caps of both sleeves should match the color scheme of the corresponding edge motifs on the front and back chest panels.
- The color schemes for both left and right sleeves should be the same as the second section of the body.

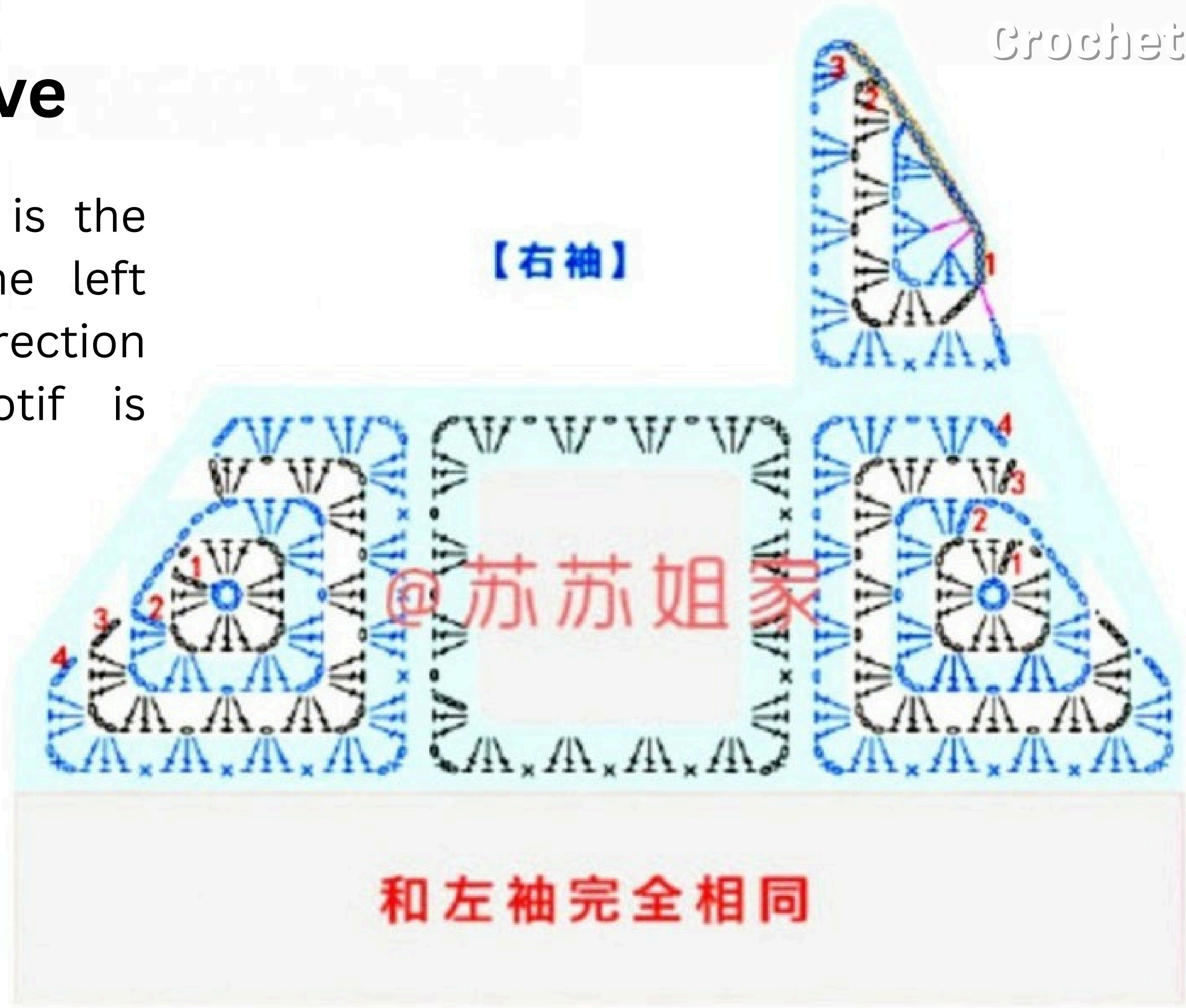
**This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> section

# Right Sleeve

The right sleeve is the same size as the left sleeve, but the direction of the last motif is opposite.

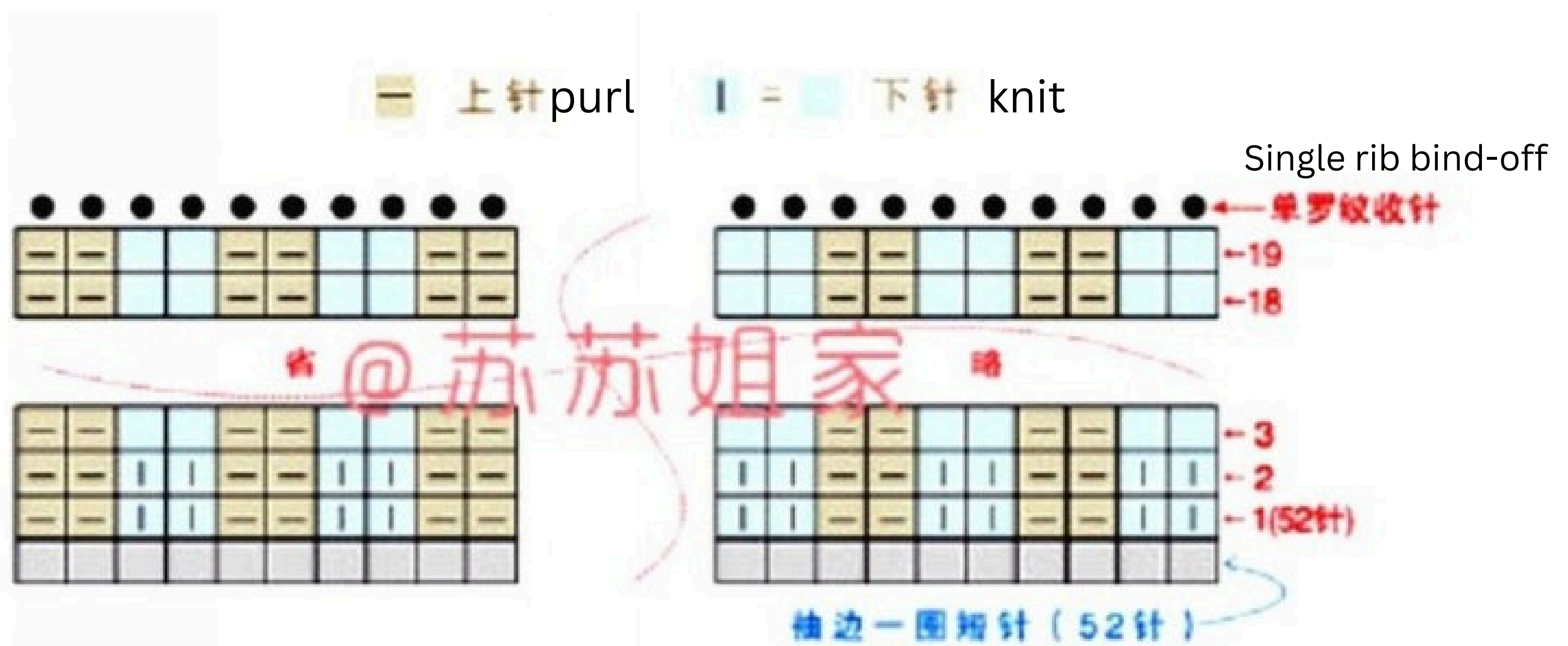




# STEP 2: Sleeve Edge

After completing the sleeve cap and sleeve body on both the left and right sleeves, continue by working in the round along the bottom edge of the sleeve.

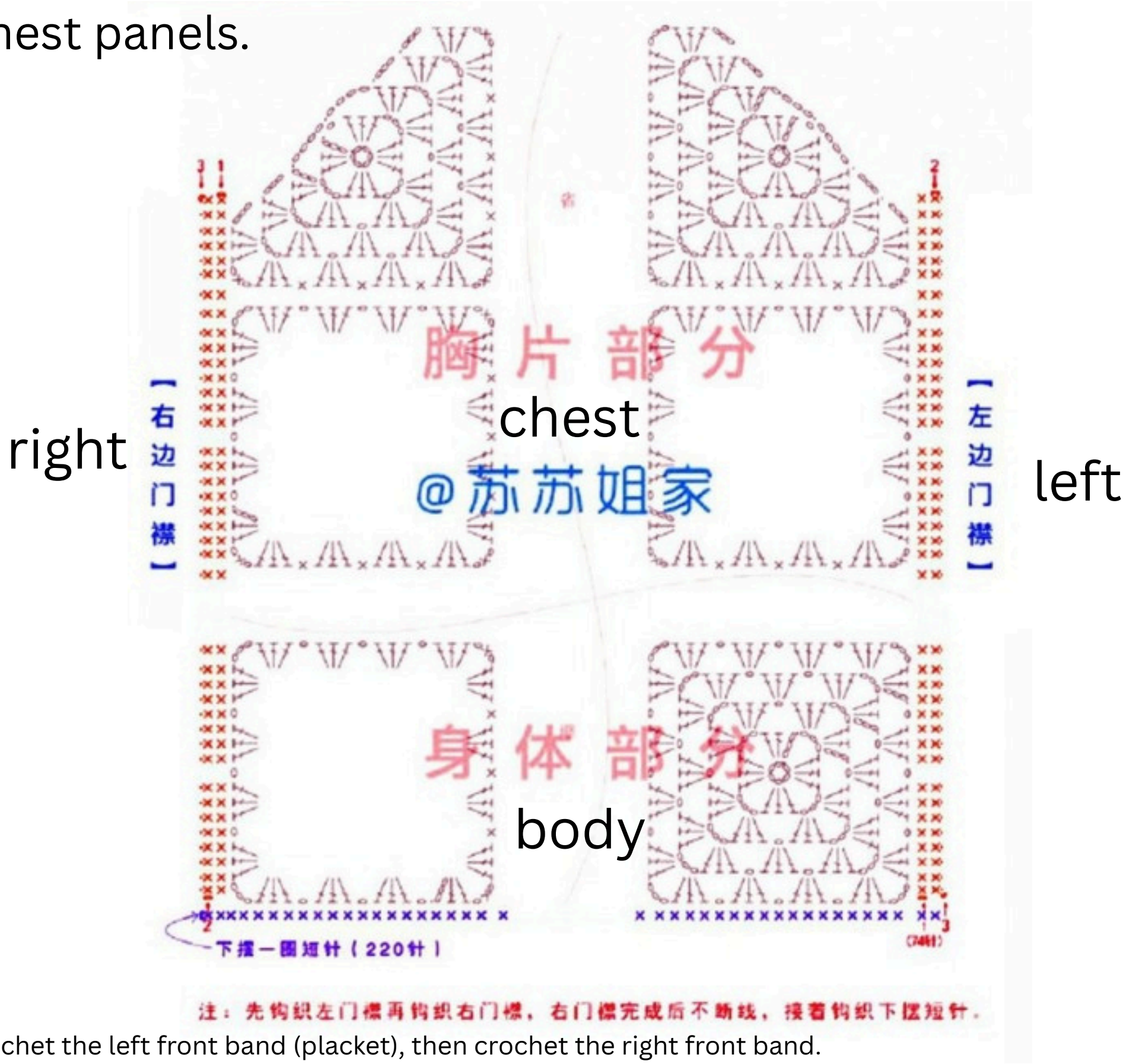
First, crochet one round of single crochet (refer to the edging diagram above), then pick up stitches and continue working the sleeve edge.

PART 4: Front Bands

The left and right front bands are crocheted using the same method. Work them back and forth along the edges of the body and chest panels.

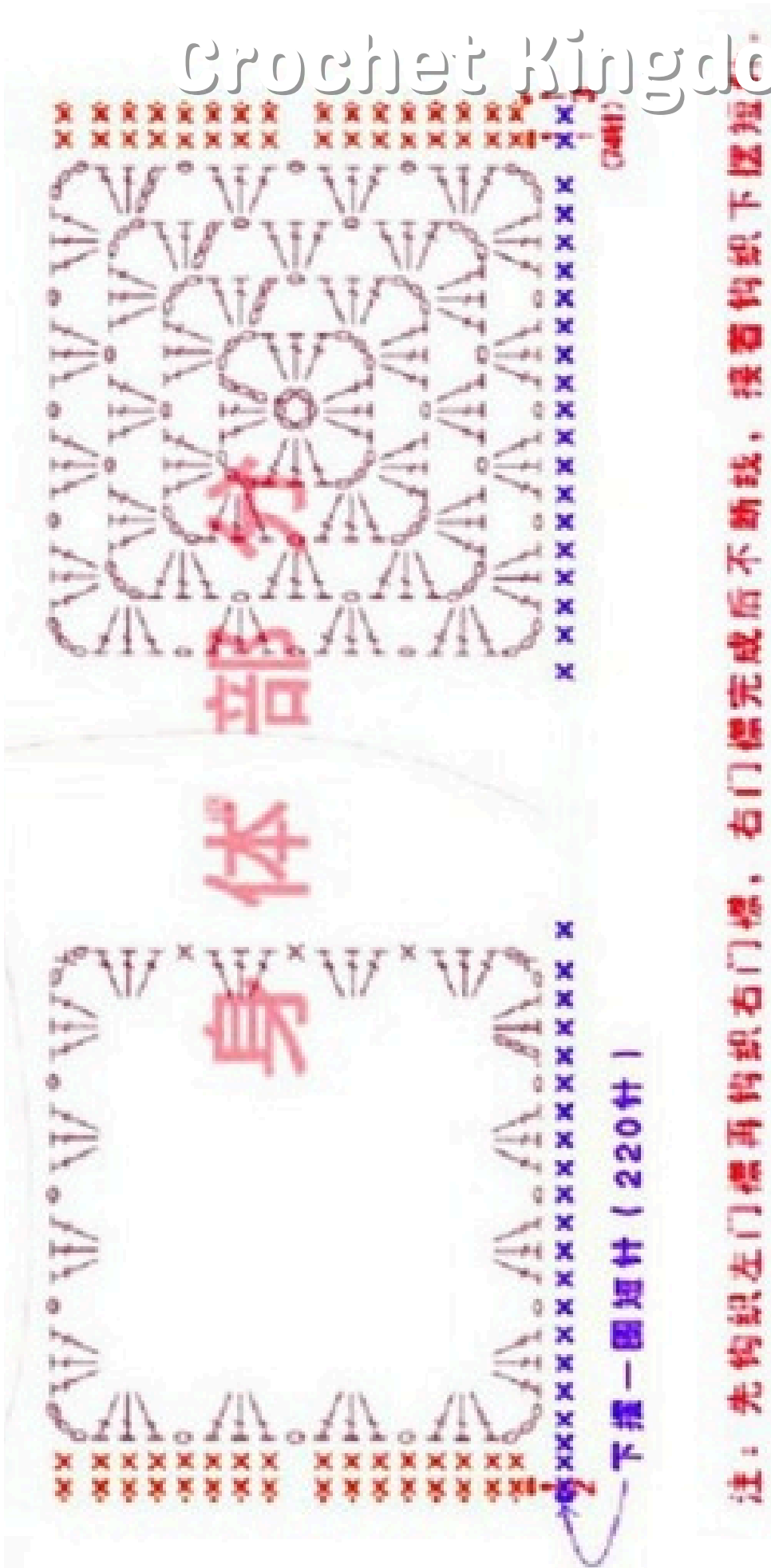
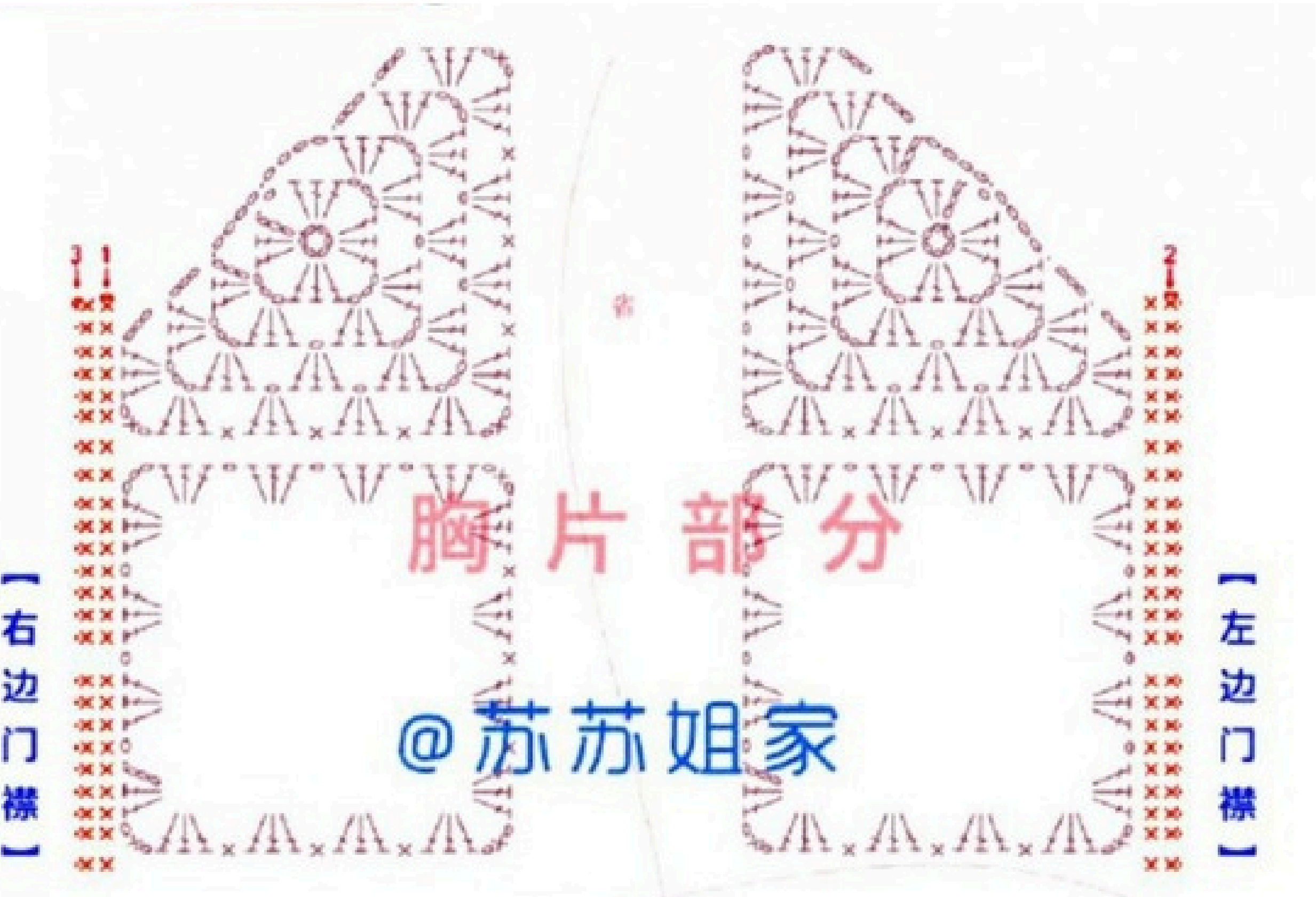


First, crochet the left front band (placket), then crochet the right front band.  
After completing the right front band, do not fasten off—continue directly to crochet single crochet stitches along the bottom hem.



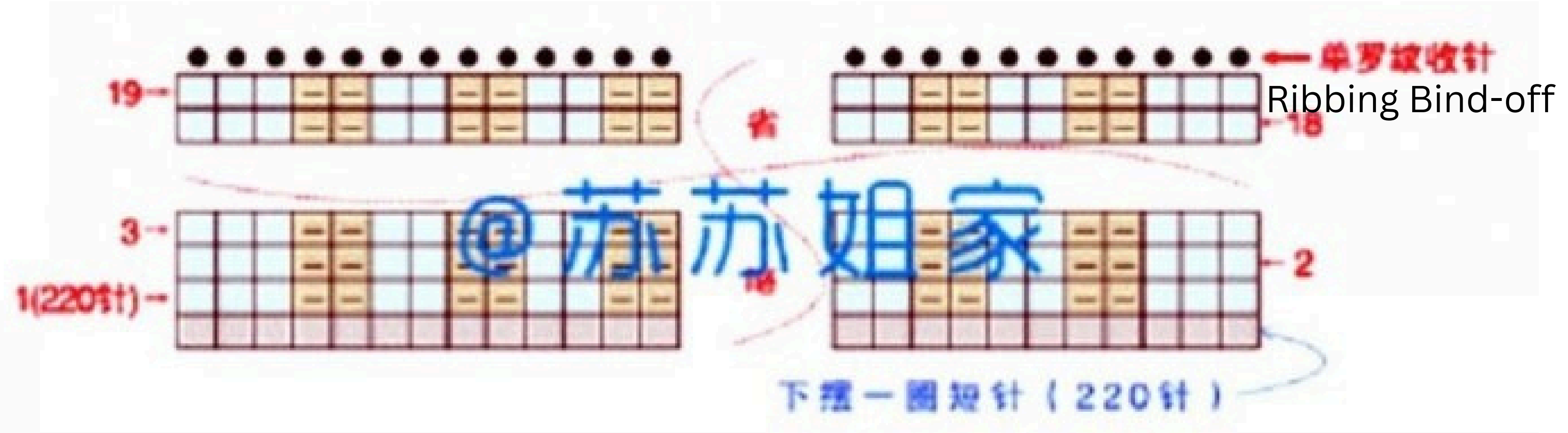
# A zoomed in version of the previous image

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PART 5: Hem

First, crochet one row of single crochet along the bottom edge of the body. Then, pick up stitches and work back and forth in double rib stitch (k2, p2).  
Finally, bind off using the single rib bind-off method to finish the edge neatly.

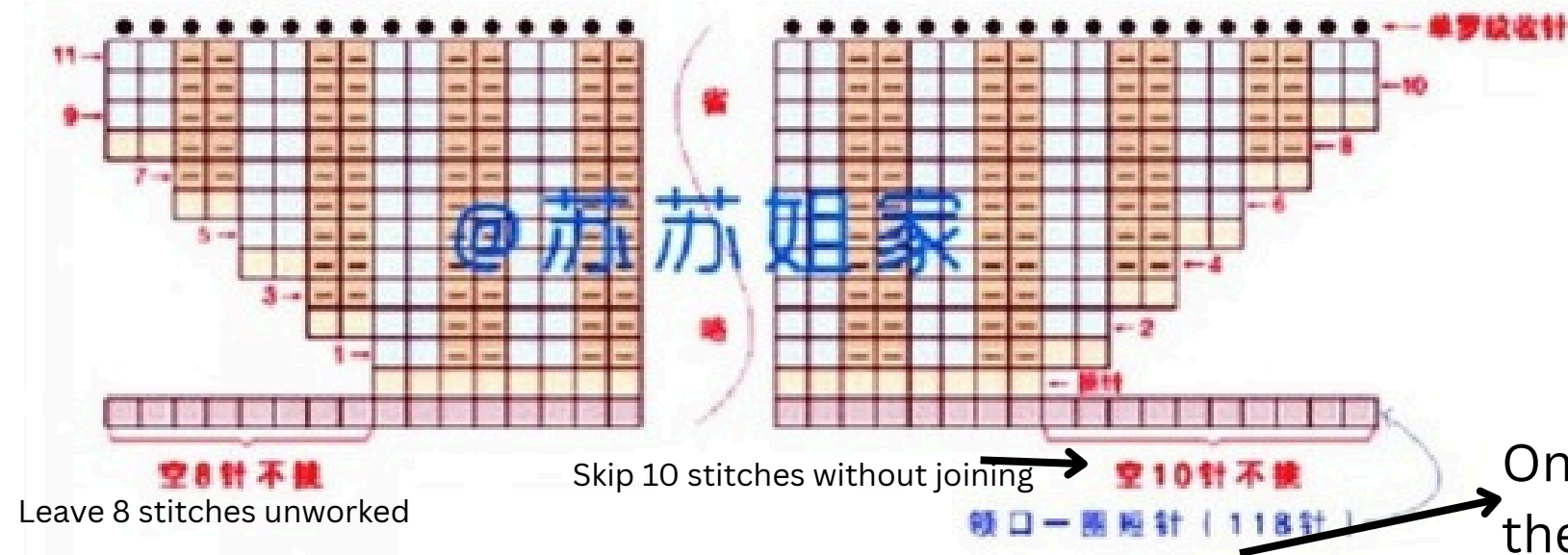

## PART 6: Neckline

At the neckline, crochet one row of single crochet, then pick up stitches and work back and forth in double rib stitch (k2, p2).

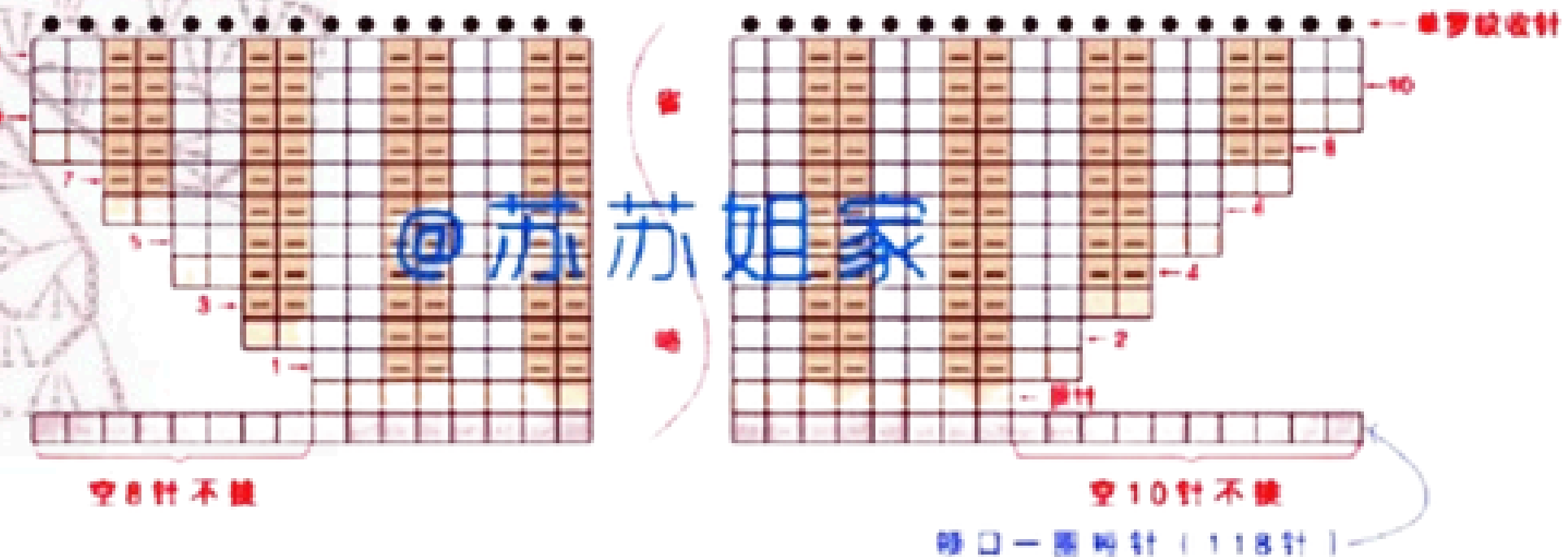
Finally, bind off using the single rib bind-off method to finish the neckline edge cleanly.
